

Sports Chapel boys, girls earn key 6A-South victories

Watson Chapel boys' basketball head coach Danny Myatt called the Wildcats' 62-58 victory against Little Rock Parkview Saturday night sweet revenge.

Chapel (9-8, 5-2 6A-South) has won their last four games and on Saturday night, they knocked off one of the state's top teams in Parkview.

"They've grown up so much from the beginning of the year," Myatt said. "We've played such a tough schedule and it showed. Every night, you've got to come out and play hard. By gosh, we did it tonight. I don't know if many people gave us a chance to win tonight, but it was big."

Sophomores Daniel Broughton and Keith Ross each scored 16 points Saturday night in the victory. Broughton had a team-high 11 rebounds against Parkview.

Chapel led 25-24 at halftime. The Wildcats jumped out to a 35-26 lead early in the third quarter behind the hot hand of Ross, who drained two three-pointers during a 10-2 run. Trey Finn led Parkview (13-6, 4-2 6A-South) with 24 points and nine rebounds.

The Wildcats will travel to El Dorado Tuesday night.
